

Snohomish County Ham's Club
Minutes of General Meeting held on 07-26-2003 at Providence Medical Center

The meeting was opened at 0800 R by President, Steve Burling, KJ7YL.

The minutes of the meeting of 05-24-2003 were read and approved.

The Treasurer's report showed that there was \$976.63 in the Checking Account and \$106.30 in the Savings Account. Income received between 05-24-2003 and 07-25-2003 included \$15 rebate from ARRL (Daniel Hosking membership) and \$0.26 Savings Account interest through June 30, 2003.

Expenses included \$44.88 for Verizon phone bill for the two months of May and June 2003.

The Checking Account balance was \$967.73 on 06-30-2003. The Savings Account remains at \$106.30. The report was approved as given.

President, Steve Burling, KJ7YL, reported that the FCC had sent the letter of apology from the repeater jammer to Jim Pratt, K7QI. Steve expressed hope that the club might get a copy of that letter.

President Steve said there was no new information to present from the Technical Committee.

President Steve reported on Field Day the last weekend of June. He said it was a success, considering the small number of members in attendance.

Frank Dolan, N7WUB, reported that he had arranged for a program to be presented next month by Tim Dehnhoffer, KD7IGJ, on RACES.

President Steve said that the Sunday night net on the repeater is temporarily suspended because of lack of interest. Loren Hole, KK7M, recommended that it remain suspended until Standard Time returns on October 26, 2003.

President Steve reported on the Aquafest activities held at Lake Stevens in ~~June~~ ^{July}. The club had six members who participated. Communication was coordinated between the Hams, Explorer Troops, Police and Event officials. There were individual runners, bike racers on Saturday, and the Aquathlon activities on Sunday.
